**Sub: Request for Addressing the Shortfall in Allotment of Clerical Candidates from the IBPS(CRP-CSA-XV) Reserve List-1**

Dear Sir,

We wish to draw your kind attention to the issue of the inadequate allotment of clerical candidates from the IBPS reserve list, which has resulted in a continued shortage of clerical staff across the Bank.

As you are aware, a large number of branches across the country are functioning with an acute shortage of clerical personnel, with several branches operating as zero-clerk branches. This situation is adversely affecting customer service, operational efficiency, and the overall functioning of the branches.

The Bank had initially placed an indent with IBPS for 418 clerical vacancies. However, following the document verification and joining process, nearly 115 selected candidates did not join the Bank. To compensate for this deficiency, the Bank reportedly sought the allotment of around 120 candidates from the IBPS reserve list.

It has, however, been observed from the latest allotment notification that only 81 candidates have been allocated to various Zones across the country, leaving a further shortfall of nearly 40 candidates against the Bank's requirement.

Sir, clerical employees are the face of the Bank and constitute the frontline workforce entrusted with delivering quality customer service and ensuring smooth day-to-day branch operations. At a time when many branches are already functioning with inadequate clerical strength, this reduced allotment is likely to aggravate the existing manpower crisis.

In view of the above, we earnestly request you to kindly examine the matter and take up the issue with the concerned authorities so that the remaining shortfall in clerical allotment is made good at the earliest. Timely augmentation of clerical manpower will go a long way in improving customer service, reducing the workload on existing employees, and enhancing operational efficiency across the Bank.

We shall be obliged for your sympathetic consideration and immediate action to address this natural concern.
